Review of Event Calendar

- Colorado
 - 7/18 – 2/23 actual driving tour
 - Plan on two days to return from Colorado Springs (last official tour destination)
- Dealership cars and coffee

- Concours

- Joseph's event
 - Discussed if or how we might extend invitations to dealership list

- John noted that if we use MSR for RSVP – it will be open to general public
- Ben and Cam will discuss with Joseph's
- March board meeting date update
 - Change date to 3/31/25 from 3/24/25
- Bill Pemberton – Idea – driving school
 - Driving event along with a track event
 - For 12 participants
 - Bob and Bill are already instructors – will need 6 instructors for the event
 - Dates to consider (Thursday – Friday)
 - 4/30 – 5/1
 - 7/9-7/10
 - 8/6 – 8/7

- New member picnic
 - Belinda asked for details – who, when, where
 - Belinda will work to confirm date
 - Jen noted that we can combine MA Hill drive and the new member event
 - To end drive at the destination of the picnic
 - Bob Eddy will contact possible hosts
 - Recommendation to have a dual recommendation
 - One for MA Hill
 - One for new member picnic
- March drive and dine – to avoid St. Patrick's Day
 - Suggests moving to 3/24
- Belinda stepping down at the end of 2026
 - Club will need a new chair
 - Belinda will work to transition
 - Dustin agreed to take over, and Belinda will continue to mentor this year
- Holiday Party 2026
 - Date not confirmed yet
 - Venue still under consideration – options include
 - Dealership
 - Foundry

- Financial considerations
 - Club should decide what we want to spend money on going forward since we will not have a big event like the 50th
- Drives TBD – February, March or August
 - Skip advised August date is a hold
 - Looking for a one-night drive
 - Dustin suggested a 4-door drive
 - Skip noted that February or March overnight drive might be good
 - Could consider Kansas City Plaza
 - Skip will research
- Drive scout finances
 - Reimbursement raised last year
 - Club pays for room and gas
 - Request drive leaders involve Skip in restaurant contracts and room blocks
 - Any food or appetizers that the trail boss wants the club to pay for – requests that these be provided to the club for approval
 - Skip will meet with each trail boss to discuss what is planned for each drive
 - Skip will provide findings to Phil in two weeks
- Options to improve communication regarding drives
 - Eric will research options to provide texts to members regarding drives
 - Drew suggested recommended sending a note to encourage members to make sure their PCA profile information is correct
- Autocross school 4/11/25 – on calendar
 - Held at Iowa State Fairway
 - Will teach people how to autocross
 - Walk and drive course
- Spinner – need for more content
 - Explore new content option
 - PCA national may help with content
